## REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

### ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN COMPETITION

FOR THE DESIGN OF MONTESSORI CHILDREN' S HOUSE AND BOARDING SCHOOLS IN  
ARUSHA AND TANGA REGIONS

1. The purpose of this design competition is to identify and select a registered architectural firm, which will be commissioned to design a Montessori Children's House and Boarding School by utilizing the prototype book 'Montessori Architecture a Design Instrument' .
2. The design competition is for two lots. Lot 1: Design a Montessori Children's House and Boarding School in Ngabombo village in Meru district in Arusha. Lot 2: Design a Montessori Children's House and Boarding School in Kwalundege village in Handeni Tanga. Interested architects may apply for one or both lots.
3. This design competition will have two key stages. Stage One seeks expressions of interest from registered architectural firms in Tanzania. Stage Two will choose three winning firms from the shortlisted expressions of interest. The top-winning firm will enter into a contract to submit a detailed design and oversee the construction work to completion.
4. Interested firms must provide their qualifications for performing the design and supervision services. Such information may include a company profile, evidence of appropriate skills and experience with a similar assignment.

5. Criteria for Eligibility: All architectural firms registered with AQRB
6. Two or more Architectural firms who are interested to join together; are also allowed to submit their expression of interest as a consortium
7. Restrictions for Eligibility: No employees of the organizers, AQRB staff, board and committee members, or jury members are eligible to compete.
8. The five-member jury will be made up of four registered architects, approved by the AQRB and the project beneficiary.
9. The official language of the competition is English.
10. Honoraria and Prizes: All participants shortlisted to enter stage two (submission of a design concept) will be awarded honoraria of T. Sh 300,000 (three hundred thousand Tanzanian Shillings) upon submission of their competition entry and feedback on the provided 'Montessori Architecture a Design Instrument' . The three top winners will be awarded a cash prize in Tanzania Shillings as follows:  
  
First Winner – T. Sh. 5,000,000 (Five Million Tanzanian Shillings)  
Second Winner – T. Sh. 4,000,000 (Four Million Tanzania Shillings)  
Third Winner – T. Sh. 3,000,000 (Three Million Tanzanian Shillings)  
  
The top winner will be contracted to complete the design of the project at a fee agreed by contest winner and the project financier.
11. The submission of expressions of interest must include the following information:
  1. Expression of interest submission letter with office letter head and official stamp
  2. Company profile
  3. Certified copies of the firm' s registration certificates of AQRB, BRELA & TRA
  4. A certified copy of the Business License and Tax Clearance
  5. CVs and certified copies of certificates of key personnel
